NIA court awards life imprisonment to IS terrorist Musa

KOLKATA : A special National Investigation Agency (NIA) court here on Friday awarded life imprisonment to Islamic State (IS) terrorist Md. Masiuddin a.k.a. Musa, officials said.

Besides IS, Musa was also closely associated with Jamaat-ul-Mujahideen Bangladesh. This is for the first time that any IS terrorist was handed punishment by a court in West Bengal.

To recall, on July 5, 2022, the sleuths of Criminal Investigation Department (CID of West Bengal police arrested Musa from Burdwan station in East Burdwan district in West Bengal. Later, he was sent to the custody of the NIA.

Musa is a resident of Laxpur in Birbhum district of West Bengal. When he was imprisoned, Musa had hit the headlines a number of times for attacking the jail wardens and prison guards.

In December 2017, he attacked a prison officer, Gobindo Chandra Dey with a sharp object, targeting his neck.

He had even once thrown shoes towards a judge within the courtroom.

Even the sleuths from the American security agency, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) came to Kolkata to question him.

Musa was accused by NIA of plotting an attack at Mother House in Central Kolkata to kill the foreign visitors there to pay homage to Nobel laureate, Mother Teresa.

According to the NIA, Musa was mainly responsible for making IS recruits from West Bengal.

Home Minister reviews security situation in J&K

NEW DELHI : In wake of the recent targeted killings in the Kashmir Valley, Home Minister Amit Shah on Friday reviewed the security situation in Jammu and Kashmir.

Jammu and Kashmir Lt. Governor Manoj Sinha, National Security Advisor (NSA) Ajit Doval, Army Chief Gen. Manoj Pande also attended the meeting.

A Home Ministry official said Amit Shah reviewed the security situation in Jammu and Kashmir. A discussion on the security arrangements for the upcoming Amarnath Yatra was also held in the meeting. The security review meeting came after recent targeted killings in the Kashmir Valley. Last month, Shah had held a meeting to review the preparedness of Amarnath Yatra, and the overall security in Jammu and Kashmir.

Centre writes to 5 states over rising Covid cases

NEW DELHI : Raising concern over spike in the number Covid-19 cases in some states, the Center on Friday wrote to Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Maharashtra, Karnataka and Kerala to continue monitoring the spread of the infection.

The Centre has advised these five states in separate letters to undertake the required steps for prompt and effective management of the pandemic.

"A sustained and significant decline in the number of Covid-19 cases has been observed in India over the past 3 months. However, from past 1 week, a slight upsurge in cases is being noticed with 15,708 cases reported in week ending May 27, 2022 rising to 21,055 cases reported in week ending June 3, 2022," the Health Ministry said.

The ministry also raised concern over rising positivity rate. "Also, there is a rise in weekly positivity from 0.52 per cent in week ending May 27, 2022 to 0.73 per cent in week ending June 3, 2022,"



said Rajesh Bhushan, Health Secretary.

Bhushan said that there are a few states which are reporting a higher contribution to India's cases indicating the possibility of a localised spread of infection.

"There is, therefore, a need to follow a risk assessment-based approach on the public health responses without losing the gains made so far in the fight against the pandemic," he added.

The Centre has advised

the states to continue implementation and monitoring of necessary measures for prompt and effective management of Covid-19 and to ensure compliance with various advisories issued by the ministry.

8,700 Jan Aushadhi Kendras providing 50-90 pc cost-effective medicines to beneficiaries across India

NEW DELHI : The government has set a target to increase the number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) to 10,000 by March 2024, as part of efforts to provide quality medicines at an affordable rate for the common man, especially the poor. In an exclusive interview with ANI, Ravi Dadhich, CEO, of Pharmaceuticals and Medical Devices Bureau of India (PMBI) said that Jan Aushadhi Kendra is providing 50 to 90 per cent cost-effective medicines to the beneficiaries.

Dadhich said, "The medicines are of extremely good quality and they are very affordable when you compare the prices of these medicines with the branded medicines they are 50 to 90 per cent cheaper."

Further explaining the aim behind the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana, he said, "The aim of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya

Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) is to provide affordable medicines to the citizens. As we all know, the out of pocket expenditure on medicines is a huge burden on the families who have any person who has fallen sick so they can purchase the medicines these are extremely good quality medicines and they are very affordable when you compare the prices of these medicines with the branded medicines."

"At present, there are 8,700 shops in the country. We aim to make it 10,000 shops in the near future so that these shops are available in all the blocks across the country very soon," he added.

The sale of medicines for regular lifestyle diseases like blood pressure or sugar-related medicines is high in demand. And since these are taken on a regular basis, the current quantum of these medicines in the sales aspect is also very high.

"We get patients from all over the country, this centre

is helping a lot of patients for those who are on some therapies, they get Rs 100 medicine in Rs 10 and they purchase medicines for 8 months also because they can't travel daily from far place", said Deepu Sharma of Jan Aushadhi Kendra at Safdarjung hospital.

Adab Singh's child Varun who is 11-years-old has tonsils, stones and throat related issues due to that his growth has been affected. He is purchasing medicines for just Rs 100-200. Earlier he used to spend higher when he had to purchase medicines from private medical stores.

"I am purchasing my son's medicines from this store at a very affordable price, I travel to this hospital for the treatment and medicines from Bulandshahr every two months of the period," said Singh. In the month of May 2022, PMBI clocked its highest monthly sales turnover of Rs 106 crores which in turn has saved around Rs 600 crore for citizens of the country.

BSF developing counter drone, anti-tunnel tech: DG



NEW DELHI : The Border Security Force is continuously working to develop counter-drone and anti-tunnel technologies to effectively check cross-border drugs and arms smuggling and terrorist infiltration bids along the India-Pakistan border, force chief Pankaj Kumar Singh said on Friday.

The BSF director general said the force has shot down a total of 7 drones over the last six months (December 2021-May 2022) and has detected three underground tunnels along the Pakistan border between January, 2021 to May, 2022.

"We are keeping a strict vigil on cross-border drone

activities through which drugs and arms are smuggled and underground tunnels which are used for infiltration by terrorists. The BSF is also working to develop effective technologies to check drones and underground tunnels," he said.

Singh was speaking during an investiture ceremony and the annual 'Rustamji Memorial Lecture' of the border force. The about 2.65 lakh personnel strong force was raised in 1965 and it is primarily tasked to guard Indian borders with

Pakistan and Bangladesh. Minister of state for home Nityanand Rai delivered the keynote speech and also honoured a total of 16 personnel, including two posthumously, with the police medal for gallantry. Those decorated include second-in-command rank officer.
