

Goa CM gives aid to slain martyr’s wife

CHANDIGARH, SEPTEMBER 28

Targeting the late Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru, Goa Chief Minister Pramod Sawant today said that had the then government cared after freedom fighters fell to the Portuguese military bullets in 1955, the state wouldn’t have to wait long for freedom.

Goa was finally liberated on December 19, 1961, after the government’s military action under Operation Vijay.

Sawant was in Chandigarh today as he had come to meet Charanjit Kaur, wife of Karnail Singh Benipal who fell to bullets during a protest in Goa in 1955. Sawant told mediapersons that though India got Independence in 1947, Goa remained under Portugal till 1961. He said on August 15, 1955, the Goa Vimochan Sahayak Samiti (GVSS), a Pune-based organisation, organised a march where people hailing from different states entered Goa against the Portugal occupation. A young widow from Madhya Pradesh, Sahodradevi Rai, was holding the Indian Tricolour and leading the group of Satyagrahis along with others at Patradevi. As their group tried to enter Goa, she was shot at and got injured. “At this point, Karnail Singh Benipal of Isru village

(Khanna) in Punjab came forward and challenged the police to shoot him instead of attacking women. He, too, was shot on the Goa border at Patradevi and became a martyr,” said Sawant. Benipal was just aged 25 then. “When I met Charanjit Kaur at Barola village (Ambala) today, she broke down, but was happy that someone from Goa had come to meet her,” he added. He presented a cheque for Rs 10 lakh to her and assured all possible help to her. Sawant announced that a road leading from Goa International Airport would be named after Shaheed Karnail Singh Benipal.

MLA Ambala, Aseem Goel, said Haryana CM had announced that the middle school at Barola village would be named after Benipal or his wife Charanjit Kaur. — TNS

per cent in the past three months, which would not be feasible for the industries.

Another important factor is that it would be very costly for all industries to change over from their existing boilers into gas-based ones as most of the industries here are medium, small and micro (MSME). For the biomass fuel, the industries have to have incumbent boilers, Goyal said.Besides, the gas boiler suppliers were limited in the country and the waiting time period to change the boilers were six months to one year, which was also a big problem for the industries to switch to the gas-based boilers, he added. The other big reason was that the state government was ready to set up a common boiler in Panipat and it would be set up by the HSI-IDC, but that would take 18-24 months, he said. Pritam Singh Sachdeva, president, Panipat Industrial Association (PIA), said the industries in Panipat were already facing a crisis and now the CAQM’s directions and implementation ofGRAP had also raised the tension of industrialists. The government will have to intervene in the matter to save the industries in Panipat, he added.

Coal-based industries fail to get relief, to shut down after Sept 30

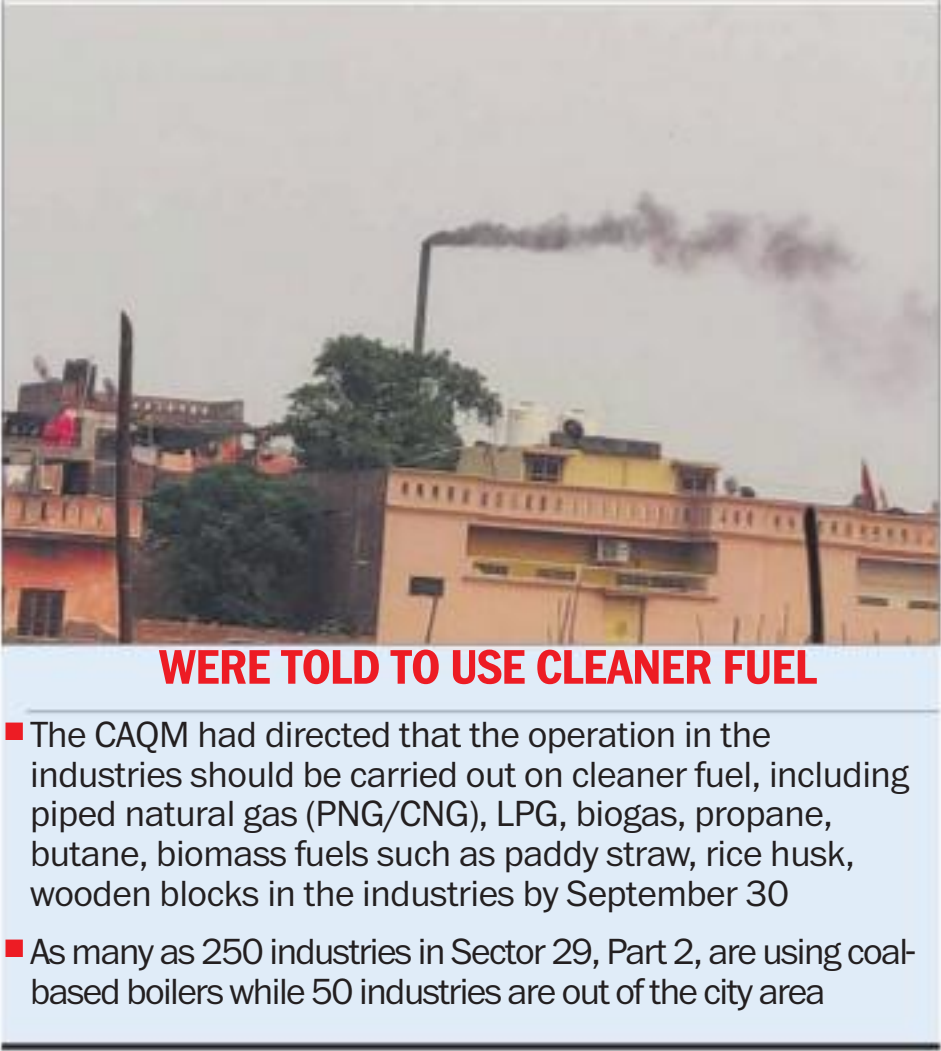
Local industries suffered a big setback when the Chairman, Commission of Air Quality Management (CAQM), refused to give these any relief. The CAQM had issued directions in February that if any industry was found running on conventional fossil fuel such as — diesel, coke, HSD — in the NCR region, it would be shut down after September 30. This had raised the worries of the industrialists.

The CAQM had, directed that the operation in the industries should be carried out on cleaner fuel, including piped natural gas (PNG/CNG), LPG, biogas, propane, butane, biomass fuels such as paddy straw, rice husk, wooden blocks in the industries by September 30.

Besides, the graded response action plan (GRAP) would come into effect from October 1 in the NCR. The Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB) has already directed the district administrations of 14 districts under the NCR to prepare for the implementation of GRAP.

Illegal properties of 3 more criminals razed in Palwal

On the second consecutive day of the drive, the police today demolished the illegal properties of three more criminals in the district.

A senior police officer said the police demolished the property of one Kajju, alias Dhan Singh, of the Baksua Patti area of Hodal. Kajju is wanted in as many as six different cases of murder, loot, assault and dacoity since 2015 and is currently serving a jail sentence. The cop said the property razed included a house, boundary

wall, tin shed and toilet built on a plot of 600 square yard. He said the second such demolition was carried out a house built on a 200 square yard plot, belonging to one Devender, alias Lala, located in Deshan Mohalla. “Lala has at least seven criminal cases of murder, assault, liquor smuggling and under the SC/ST Act registered against him. He is also in judicial custody at present.”

The third demolition was done at Lalwa village of the district, where a dhaba and a shop, owned by one Kapil, was razed. According to the police, Kapil is wanted in

around 11 cases, including that of a murder booked in 2010. Seven cases of liquor smuggling and two of assault have also been registered against Kapil, who has served jail sentences many times in the past 12 years. All properties had come up on the encroached land or illegally, it is claimed.

Claiming that the drive would continue as part of the directions of the state government, a senior cop said it was aimed at curbing the crime and the acquisition of properties through money earned illegally.
