'71 war, 72-hr courage: When Bhuj women fixed a runway

A GRAINY black and white photograph published over 50 years ago in Kutchmitra, a vernacular newspaper in Gujarat, shows a group of women in chaniya-cholis waiting next to a concrete mixer.

The photograph, proof of a singular act of courage, was from 1971, when nearly 300 women from a nearby village worked 12 hours each for three days to repair the 4-km airstrip at the Bhuj air base, rendered unusable after heavy bombing by the Pakistan Air Force on the intervening night of December 8-9, 1971.

Though the base had been bombed on December 4, 1971, too, the attack on the intervening night of December 8-9 had sent the labourers hired for repairs running for their lives. Later on December 9, women from Madhapar village, around 5 km from Bhuj, turned up at the base to "save the country".

During his visit to Bhuj on May 26 this year, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had greeted the viranganas (brave women) from Madhapar village for their bravery during the third India-Pakistan War, which lasted

around 15 days and culminated in the creation of Bangladesh.

Madhapar's Kanbai Shivji Hirani, 80, was among these volunteers. Inside her two-room house in the village, a showcase is overflowing with memento trophies acknowledging her act of bravery 54 years ago. "There were three holes — as big as my house — on the airstrip (in 1971), along with several smaller ones," she tells The Indian Express.

In her early 20s in 1971, Kanbai recalls brushing aside protests from her husband and

mother-in-law after she informed them about her resolve to help rebuild the airstrip. At the time of these bombings, the air base was under the command of then 30-year-old Commander Vijay Karnik. One of the youngest officers to command an air base in India, he had joined the Air Force in March 1962 and retired in 1993 as Wing Commander. He says repairing the runway after the December 4 attack proved to be more challenging than anticipated. He says work on the tarmac had started, but the December 9 bombings made the workers flee.

"I approached the local administration for help but was told that the labourers had refused to return to the base. Having seen women of all ages work as construction labourers, then Kutch Collector (N Gopalaswami), the sarpanch and I turned to the local leaders

for help," Wg Cdr Karnik (retd), 86, says. N Gopalaswami, the former Chief Election Commissioner who now lives in Chennai, told The Indian Express, "I informed the sarpanch that getting men from far away would be difficult. Within two hours, he managed to gather women for these repairs."

As dawn broke on December 9, 1971, a vehicle deposited around 50 Madhapar women at the base. Though men, including Kanbai's husband, were also present at the tarmac while the women worked from 7 am to 7 pm for three days, she says they were there "only to shadow us and not to help".

Sambai Karsan Khokhani, 83, says an Air Force officer told them about the damaged runway. "It took us one whole day just to see the full runway. We were scared at first but realised that if we don't repair it, no one else will."

Bhavesh Bhudia, 33, a resident of Madhapar and a senior clerk with the Bhuj panchayat, says his maternal grandmother, Premibai Pancha Singhani, who was among the 300 volunteers, passed away at the age of 85 in 2024.

Jadavji Varsani, a trustee at the local Swaminarayan Temple was instrumental in inspiring these women to volunteer for the dangerous task. In 1971, he says, Madhapar's Navava area had around 500 houses and a small Swaminarayan Temple that had a siren. "The village had just two landlines, including the one at my house. In case of danger, the Bhuj telephone exchange would call and say 'siren' thrice. I would sound the temple siren

after that," he says.

Kanbai, among the first lot, says "nearly 250 more women" joined in the next day. The volunteers, says Wg Cdr Karnik (retd), turned up despite facing resistance from their families.

On their first day, the women turned up without food. Kanbai says they "drank hot water" to quell hunger pangs. Wg Cdr Karnik (retd) discovered this the next day, when more women joined in. "When we offered them food, they told us they cannot eat outside food as followers of the Swaminarayan movement," he says.

Members of the Bhuj Swaminarayan Temple were informed. Soon, the locals collected jaggery, ghee and wheat to make sukhdhi (a traditional Gujarati sweet) and chikki (peanut brittle) for the volunteers.

Wg Cdr Karnik (retd) said the volunteers were also given basic training on the dos and don'ts in case an enemy plane was spotted. "We told them to hide under the green cover as soon as they heard the siren. One aircraft kept circling the base while these women fixed it."

Lauding the valour of the Madhapar volunteers, Wg Cdr Karnik (retd) recalls, "Prime Minister Indira Gandhi's visited the Bhuj air base on December 24, 1971. It was the only air base she visited after the war. She had lunch with the women of Madhapar. When men refused to repair the runway, these untrained women came forward to do the job. And what a fantastic job they did."

STUDENT HAD FILED COMPLAINT IN DEC 2024

Anna univ rape convict given life term without remission by court

A MAHILA COURT in Chennai Monday sentenced A Gnasekaran, the sole accused in the 2024 Anna University campus rape case, to life imprisonment without possibility of remission.

The court ordered that he must serve a minimum of 30 years in prison and imposed a fine of ₹90,000 on him.

Mahila Court judge M Rajalakshmi handed down the sentence four days after convicting Gnasekaran on 11 charges, including rape, abduction, wrongful confinement, and criminal intimidation under the BNS, the IT Act, and the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act. The judgment came nearly six months after the 19-year-old student filed a complaint on December 24, 2024.

According to police, on the night of December 23, the student and a male friend were sitting in the campus when Gnasekaran, a 37-year-old roadside biryani vendor with a criminal record, confronted them. He pretended to record a video of them and used the threat of exposing the footage to manipulate and separate them. He then sexually assaulted the

woman in a secluded spot and recorded it on his phone. He attempted to blackmail her, threatening to send the footage to her father and college authorities if she did not comply with his demands.

The student, however, refused to be silenced. With support from her family and college, she approached Kotturpuram All Women Police Station the next day. Gnasekaran was arrested on December 25.

The case gained national attention after the FIR containing the survivor's identity was uploaded in the official website, which was then circulated among media persons.

The Madras HC took suo motu cognisance and pulled up the state police for both the tone of the FIR and the security lapses on campus. It formed an SIT of senior women IPS officers to take over

the probe, which filed a 100-page chargesheet on February 24.

During sentencing arguments, the defence pleaded for leniency, citing Gnasekaran's aged mother and young daughter. The prosecution, however, strongly opposed it and demanded the maximum penalty. Judge Rajalakshmi upheld the prosecution's argument, calling the assault "a premeditated act exploiting institutional vulnerabilities."

The court's decision to impose a life sentence without remission — rare in cases not involving multiple victims or minors — has been seen as sending a stern message against sexual violence on campuses.

(PTI adds: Welcoming the judgment, Tamil Nadu CM M K Stalin said the very stringent punishment has been secured and thanked the court. The chief minister recalled that recently the government had made amendments ruling out remission for sexual offenders. Welcoming the sentence, AIADMK general secretary Edappadi K Palaniswami alleged that the "Stalin-model government" tried to rescue "DMK sympathiser Gnasekaran" and it was the AIADMK that scuttled such attempts by its struggle for justice and it ensured punishment for the offender).

'Is it so difficult to be patriotic?' Khurshid after backing end of Art 370

CONGRESS LEADER and former External Affairs Minister Salman Khurshid on Monday said it was "distressing" that while he is abroad on a "mission against terrorism", people at home are "calculating political allegiances".

His comments come days after he backed the abrogation of Article 370, prompting the BJP to target the Congress, which holds a nuanced position on the issue.

"When on mission against terrorism, to carry India's message to the world, it's distressing that people at home are calculating political allegiances. Is it so difficult to be patri-

otic?" Khurshid said in a post on X during a visit to Kuala Lumpur as part of an all-party delegation to rally support for India's war against terror emanating from Pakistan.

He later told ANI: "People keep saying, 'what are you doing in a delegation where there are people from BJP... What are we doing here? We are doing here is, what is needed for the country. No matter which party you are from, today what is needed is a single voice to speak in favour of the nation..."

In Jakarta Friday, Khurshid said it was unfortunate that Pakistan wants to undo the "prosperity that has come to Kashmir" because of the abrogation of Article 370. Addressing think tanks and academia, he said, "Kashmir had a major problem for a long time. Much

of that was reflected in the thinking of the government in an Article called 370 of the Constitution, which somehow gave the impression that it (Kashmir) was separate from the rest of the country. Article 370 was abrogated, finally put to an end..."

While the Congress refused to comment on Khurshid's remarks on Article 370, BJP leaders targeted the party, with national spokesperson Shehzad Poonawala saying he hoped Congress does not "designate Salman Khurshid as 'super pravakta (super spokesperson)' after he has busted their narrative on 370". It was a dig at Congress spokesperson Udit Raj who recently said party MP Shashi Tharoor, who is leading one of the delegations, should be designated by the BJP as a "super spokesperson".

'Marrying multiple times not crime': RJD MP backs Tej Pratap

TEJ PRATAP Yadav who was expelled from RJD last week over his alleged extramarital relationship reported support from party MP Sudhakar Singh on Monday. Defending party chief Lalu Prasad's elder son, whom the family has disowned, the Buxar MP and former state minister said marrying multiple times had been "accepted" in Hindu traditions, and urged Lalu to accept his son's decision.

"Marriage is a personal matter, but I don't consider it a crime... We follow the footsteps of Ram Manohar Lohia who, in his book

on Sapt Kranti, wrote that all relationships between a man and a woman are valid except for rape and deceit. If Tej Pratap ji has married again, I don't see it as an immoral act... I personally, don't believe it is. In Hindu traditions, having two or even three to four marriages has been accepted, and we have heard of such cases. Even today, many such marriages take place," Singh said.

Referring to the late Lok Janshakti Party (LJP) chief Ram Vilas Paswan's second marriage, he said, "Take (Union Minister) Chirag Paswan, for instance. He was born to Paswan's second wife. Many people have had two or three marriages, everyone knows this. It's neither a big deal nor is it a crime. As a father, Lalu Prasad should accept him."

Paswan married air hostess Reena Sharma, Chirag's mother, in 1983. In 2014, after his opposition challenged his Lok Sabha nomination papers about omitting his first wife's name, Paswan disclosed that he had divorced her in 1981. Singh argued that "such instances are still not uncommon and should not be seen as a social evil".

Last week, a photo on Tej Pratap's official Facebook account showed him with a woman, with the caption claiming that he had been in a relationship with her for over 12 years. He later claimed that his account had been hacked. Soon afterwards, Lalu disowned his son and expelled him from the party for six years, citing his "irresponsible behaviour" that does not align with the family's values.

महानगर संवाददाता नई दिल्ली। लोगों का डिजिटल पेमेंट की तरफ किस तरह तेजी के साथ रुझान बढ़ा है, इसका अंदाजा आप इस बात से लगा सकते हैं कि सिर्फ मई के महीने में ही 18.68 बिलियन का ट्रांजेक्शन हुआ है। यह अप्रैल महीने के मुकाबले 4 प्रतिशत ज्यादा है। इससे पहले, अप्रैल में 17.89 बिलियन का ट्रांजेक्शन हुआ था। अगर इसे करेंसी के हिसाब से देखा



जाए तो मई के महीने में यह 25.14 लाख करोड़ रुपए का ट्रांजेक्शन है, जो एक महीने पहले अप्रैल में 23.95 करोड़ रुपए था। नेशनल पेमेंट कॉर्पोरेशन ऑफ इंडिया के मुताबिक, पिछले साल के मुकाबले जहां यूपीआई पेमेंट में यह 33 प्रतिशत का इजाफा है तो वहीं अप्रैल की तुलना में करीब 14 फीसदी ज्यादा बढ़ा है। मई के महीने में औसतन रोजाना 602 मिलियन ट्रांजेक्शन हुआ है।

इसका कुल मूल्य 81,106 करोड़ रुपए का है। गौरतलब है कि देश में 2016 में शुरू हुए यूपीआई को खासकर नोटबंद की के बाद पॉपुलरिटी मिली है। एक तरफ जहां स्मार्टफोन तेजी से लोगों के पास पहुंचा है तो वहीं फोन पे, गूगल पे और पेटोएम जैसे एप ने डिजिटल भुगतान को और मजबूत किया है। ऐसे में डिजिटल भुगतान में यूपीआई ने तेजी के साथ अपना दायरा बढ़ाया है। समीक्षाधीन महीने में आधार सक्षम

लीला होटल आईपीओ निवेशकों को नहीं मिला मुनाफा, 406 पर लिस्ट हुए शेयर, प्राइस बैंड से 6.7 फीसदी नीचे

नई दिल्ली। लीला होटल ब्रांड की मालिक कंपनी श्लॉस वैंगलोर लिमिटेड (लीला होटल्स आईपीओ) के शेयर सोमवार को शेयर बाजारों में 6.5 फीसदी के डिस्काउंट पर लिस्ट हुए। एनएसई आईपीओ लिस्टिंग ग्रे मार्केट अनुमानों से कम रही। लिस्टिंग से पहले लीला होटल्स के अनलिस्टेड शेयर 437 प्रति शेयर के आसपास कारोबार कर रहे थे। यह इश्यू प्राइस से 2 रुपए या 4.6 प्रतिशत के ग्रे मार्केट प्रीमियम पर मिला रहे थे। लीला होटल आईपीओ एक बुक बिल्ड इश्यू था। इसके तहत 5.75 करोड़ नए शायरी जारी किए गए। साथ ही 2.3 करोड़ शेयरों का ऑफर फॉर सेल



भी शामिल था। कंपनी ने इस इश्यू में 75 प्रतिशत हिस्सा योग्य संस्थागत खरीदारों (क्यूआईबीएस) के लिए रिजर्व किया है, जबकि 15 प्रतिशत हार्ड नेटवर्क निवेशकों और 10 प्रतिशत रिटेल निवेशकों के लिए रखा गया था। आईपीओ का प्राइस बैंड 413 से 435 प्रति शेयर तय किया गया था। इसमें न्यूनतम एक लॉट 34 शेयरों का है। यानी एक खुदरा निवेशक को कम से कम 14,790 निवेश करने होंगे। अधिकतम 13 लॉट यानी 442 शेयरों के लिए बोली लगाई जा सकती है, जिसकी कुल कीमत 1,92,270 थी। कंपनी इस इश्यू से जुटाई गई राशि का उपयोग अपने और अपनी चार सर्विसडियरी कंपनियों के पुराने कर्ज को चुकाने में करेगी। साथ ही, कुछ राशि सामान्य कॉर्पोरेट उद्देश्यों में भी लगाई जाएगी।

रूसी तेल का भारत में आयात होगा मुश्किल अमेरिकी सीनेटरों ने पेश किया 500 फीसदी शुल्क का प्रस्ताव

नई दिल्ली। रूस द्वारा पिछले सप्ताह यूक्रेन पर बमबारी करने के बाद अमेरिका के सबसे शक्तिशाली सीनेटरों में से एक ने रूस के कच्चे तेल के कारोबार पर प्रतिबंध बढ़ाने के लिए एक विधेयक का प्रस्ताव रखा है। उद्योग के अधिकारियों और शिप ट्रेडिंग के आंकड़ों के मुताबिक यह कानून लागू हुआ तो भारत के रूसी तेल के आयात को पंगु बना देगा। नए कटौत उपायों में रूसी तेल खरीदने वाले देशों पर 500 प्रतिशत शुल्क लगाने जैसे 'द्वितीयक प्रतिबंध' शामिल होंगे। इन उपायों से भारत और चीन को निराना बनाया जाएगा। प्रस्तावित कानून से रोजाना लगभग 20 लाख बैरल (बोपीओ) रूसी कच्चे तेल की आपूर्ति खतरे में पड़ जाएगी, जिसकी कीमत फरवरी में रूसी तेल की डिलीवरी दरों पर लगभग 15.4 करोड़ डॉलर प्रतिदिन है। इसकी गणना भारतीय सीमा शुल्क के आंकड़ों के आधार पर की गई है। सीमा शुल्क के आंकड़ों से पता चलता है कि वित्त वर्ष 2024-25 में भारत ने लगभग 50 अरब डॉलर का रूसी कच्चा तेल खरीदा। यह भारत के कच्चे तेल के कुल आयात बिल का करीब 35 प्रतिशत है। सूत्रों ने बताया कि डेमोक्रेटिक और रिपब्लिकन सांसद अमेरिकी प्रतिबंध सख्त करने के लिए लॉबिंग कर रहे हैं। डेमोक्रेटिक सीनेटर रिचर्ड ब्लूमफ़ेल्ड ने सोमवार को सीएनएन को बताया, 'हम सभी लोग अपने सार्वजनिक बयानों के साथ-साथ निजी संबंधों के माध्यम से इसके लिए बहुत दबाव बना रहे हैं।' सीएनएन ने बताया कि ब्लूमफ़ेल्ड सीनेट में एक ऐसे विधेयक का समर्थन कर रहे हैं, जिसे डेमोक्रेट और रिपब्लिकन दोनों का समर्थन प्राप्त है, जिसमें अमेरिका के राष्ट्रपति डॉनल्ड ट्रंप के सहयोगी सीनेटर लिंडसे ग्रहम भी शामिल हैं। अब तक 80 से अधिक सीनेटरों ने इस बिल पर हस्ताक्षर किए हैं।
