Contractor hacked to death by six-member gang

A 35-year-old man was hacked to death by a six-member gang near Ennore on Thursday morning.

The deceased V Kamaraj, from Wimco Park Nagar in Thiruvottiur was a contractor with the Public Works Department (PWD), said the police. Kamaraj is the son of a district DMK functionary,

Vivekanandan.

Kamaraj owns an office along the Thiruvottiur highway near Ennore. "At around 9 am, when Kamaraj was at his office a gang of six men barged in and picked up an argument with him," said a police officer. As the argument escalated, the gang attacked Kamaraj with machetes. When he tried to flee, the gang chased him hacked him on the road and fled in

their bikes.

Passersby rushed Kamaraj to the hospital, where he succumbed in the afternoon.

After a preliminary investigation, police said they suspect he was murdered due to a business rivalry. "We found that few other groups were vying for government tenders and on most occasions, Kamaraj bagged the contracts. We suspect this could be a motive for murder," said a senior police officer. A probe is on.

Apollo uses Synergistic Device Strategy for treatment of heart blocks

A team of doctors from Apollo Hospital, led by Dr Sengottuvelu, interventional cardiologist and clinical lead, structural heart disease programme have recently used a 'synergistic device strategy' to treat complex heart blocks on over 50 patients.

Dr Sengottuvelu said patients who already have had heart surgeries are also presenting with major blocks. These blocks have to be removed before stenting. So, like how multiple machines are used to drill a hole, we use multiple devices to remove these blocks.

This is called a 'synergistic device strategy'.

Notable cases include a 75-year-old woman with a densely calcified lesion, the recovery of a 54-year-old doctor with left main disease and a 77-year-old patient with previous bypass surgery who had a cardiac arrest at his house.

Dr Sengottuvelu recently demonstrated the specialised techniques at prestigious international forums, in association with the Asian Pacific Society of Interventional Cardiology and European Bifurcation Club and received peer acclaim.

Suneeta Reddy, managing director, Apollo Hospitals Group was also present at the event.



Man charred to death as house catches fire

Chennai: A 55-year-old man died when his house in Kannagi Nagar caught fire on Wednesday night. According to Kannagi Nagar police, the man was identified as Murthy. He was employed as a security guard at Santhome and stayed alone. On Wednesday night, after finishing his work he returned home and went to sleep around 11 pm. He had lighted a mosquito coil and placed it near his bed. The police suspect the coil could have accidentally fallen on the bed and the sheet caught fire. On information, a tender vehicle from Thoraipakkam fire station rushed to the spot and put out the fire. ENS

Two killed, one injured as bikes collide head-on

TWO men died and a minor boy sustained injury in a head-on collision between two bikes near Kancheepuram on Wednesday night.

According to Tiruvallur Taluk police, the deceased are Murthy (27) and Anandhan (50) and the injured boy is Sathish (17).

Around 11 pm, Murthy, an AC mechanic, was returning home to Kuruvimalai. When

he was near the Palar river bridge, a bike coming from the opposite direction which was driven by Murthy with Sathish riding pillion collided with their vehicle.

Anandhan sustained severe injuries to his head and died on the spot. On information, police rushed to the spot and sent Murthy and Sathish to the hospital. However, Murthy succumbed to his injuries. A case has been registered and an inquiry is on.

Taps run dry in Ambattur zone as water supply hits rock bottom

FOR residents of the Ambattur zone, the last six months have been synonymous with dry taps as the supply from the metro water has been unreliable. Groundwater levels have also plummeted and this adds to their woes.

When TNIE visited Ward 82 recently, the residents said they had lodged several complaints regarding the inadequate water supply to the area. VK Muralidharan, a resident of Venkatapuram said, "We have not



received metro water for six months. Despite multiple pleas to authorities, no action has been taken." Residents are now relying on borewells and private suppliers for drinking water purposes.

P Vidya, another resident, said that the water supply is infrequent and there is a foul odour to it. Despite paying annual water charges of ₹3,200, residents feel let down by the poor service.

A senior official from metro water told TNIE, "The excess chlorine water is the reason for the smell and it is not a cause

for concern." Explaining the situation, the official said water is sourced from Puzhal lake and some apartments store water in large sumps, leading to insufficient supply at the tail-end. To resolve the issue, new pipelines are being laid from Chembarambakkam, which will be completed within three months, he added.
