A leader of INDI Alliance said indecent words in the assembly in which mothers, sisters were present. Not only this, no leader of INDI Alliance was prepared to speak a word against such dangerous insult of sisters, mothers," a visibly angry Modi told an election rally in Guna in Madhya Pradesh while refraining from mentioning Nitish's name.

Slamming the JD(U) leader, Modi said such remarks besmirched the country's reputation. "How unfortunate for the country. How much you will fall and you are insulting the country," he added.

Amid surging outrage over his remarks, Nitish offered an apology: "If my words were wrong, then I apologise for that. If anyone got hurt by my words, I take them back," he told reporters.

With an aggressive BJP demanding his resignation for insulting women, Nitish followed up the regret by saying, "I also condemn my



own speech." But that failed to pacify the BJP which escalated the issue into a question of his eligibility to hold office by bringing up his "memory loss".

"I feel ashamed as a Bi-hari. The obscene gutter language indicates that Nitish ji has lost his mind. We were already hearing that he keeps forgetting names of his close colleagues," said Union power minister R K Singh.

Leader of opposition in Bihar assembly Vijay Sinha accused Nitish of humiliating women and said that he had ceased to be eligible

to be a member of the House. "He has lost his memory and needs to step down," he told reporters.

Significantly, Sinha raised questions about the health and mental faculty of Nitish, venturing into a territory that politicians have so far avoided. "His memory loss is complete and he needs to be examined since it is a coterie of corrupt officers and a few others who have taken charge and have been running the affairs," the BJP leader, breaking free of the restraint that politicians have so far exercised, said

Parl ethics panel set to suggest sacking of Mahua Moitra

New Delhi: The Ethics Committee of Lok Sabha will meet on Thursday to draft a report on the cash-for-query allegation against Trinamool Congress MP Mahua Moitra amid indications that the panel may recommend her sacking, taking a grim view of the charges made against her.

BJP MP Nishikant Dubey had approached Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla against Moitra, accusing her of asking questions in the Lok Sabha to target the Adani Group at the behest of businessman Darshan Hirani in exchange for gifts. Sources suggested that the panel has prepared a 500-page report in which it has suggested sacking of Mahua and also action against BSP's Danish Ali for making personal allegations against committee chief Vinod Sonkar.

BJP MP Nishikant Dubey on Wednesday claimed that based on his complaint, the anti-corruption ombudsman Lokpal has ordered a CBI investigation against



Trinamool Congress MP Mahua Moitra in the 'cash-for-query' row. In a post on X, Dubey said, "Lokpal today, based on my complaint, ordered a CBI inquiry against MP Mahua ji, who committed corruption by mortgaging national security." Earlier, Dubey lodged a complaint with the Lokpal against the Trinamool Congress leader on October 21.

"(I am) tired of hearing CBI, CBI. I filed a complaint (against Mahua Moitra) with the Lokpal today. The Lokpal is the only authority that is mandated to look into complaints of corruption or impropriety against MPs, ministers, or other people's representatives," Nishikant Dubey said.

Reacting to the news about the CBI initiating the inquiry, Mahua Moitra retorted by once again dragging in the Adani group.

"For the media calling me, my answer is: I CBI needs to first file FIR on Rs 13,000 crore Adani coal scam

2. The national security issue is how dodgy FPI-owned (inc Chinese and UAE) Adani firms are buying Indian ports and airports with Home Ministry clearance. Then CBI is welcome to come and count my shoes," Moitra posted on X.

Meanwhile, the Ethics Committee of the Lok Sabha, which is investigating the cash-for-query allegations against Trinamool Congress MP Mahua Moitra by BJP MP Nishikant Dubey, will meet on November 9 for the "consideration and adoption" of its draft report. Earlier, the meeting of the panel headed by Vinod Kumar Sonkar was scheduled to be convened on November 7.

Moitra had appeared before the Lok Sabha Ethics Committee on November 2 over the cash-for-query allegations against her. Along with opposition members of the panel, she "walked out" of the meeting. Opposition members raised questions over the line of questioning and alleged that "personal questions" were posed to the Trinamool Congress MP.

Days before Dhanteras, Modi amplifies 'vocal for local' pitch

New Delhi: Just days before Dhanteras, the biggest day on the shopping calendar of Indians, PM Narendra Modi has amplified the "vocal for local" pitch urging people to buy products which have been made locally. He has also appealed to people to post a selfie with the product or the maker

on the NaMo App.

In a social media post, Modi said, "Let us use the power of digital media to support local talent, encourage the creativity of fellow Indians and keep our traditions thriving" while urging people to try to insist on using the UPI digital payment system to make payments.

Modi's thrust on buying lo-

cally made items during the festival also comes after the recent launch of the PM Vishwakarma scheme to equip craftspeople with the technology to augment their skills for the modern market. During the launch of the scheme, he had asked people to purchase local products for the forthcoming festivals.

Meanwhile, to connect people of Delhi with PM's call for buying locally-made prod-

ucts, the Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), on Wednesday started five-day long "Diwali Utsav" where a special range of local products are available to ensure that more and more locally manufactured products reach the common people. "When Khadi products are sold, they provide economic self-reliance to the artisans working in rural India," the government said.
