Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) authorities have raised a demand of ESI Contribution of Rs.206.38 Crores u/s 45A of the ESI Act, the same was stayed for recovery by the Employees Insurance court, Mumbai vide its order dated 28.09.2017. The said 1 demand was further quashed and set aside by the Judge, Employees Insurance Court, Mumbai vide its order dated 28.04.2022. Employees State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) authorities have filed claim as per above demand of Rs Rs.206.38 Crores along with interest of Rs 154.70 Crores. The matter is pending in dispute before the Bombay High Court, pending adjudication thereof a notional amount of Rs 1 (Indian Rupee One only) is admitted. The remaining amount is classified as contingent.
